Transfer Station Etiquette: Do's & Don'ts

 <u>30-gallon maximum size limit</u>
- Residents will self sticker bags <u>Not the attendants</u>
- Residents will dispose of their own trash bags
- Residents will sort recyclables to their respective bin
- Residents are not allowed in the Universal Waste Building.

PARTIAL LISTING OF FEE SCHEDULE

We have a pay per bag policy. Rubbish bags up to <u>30</u>gallon size must have a sticker on it that can be purchased at the Town Office or local stores; stickers are \$1.50 each. Stickers can only be used for household rubbish. All other permits must be purchased at the Town Office. Stickers & permits are NOT sold at the Transfer Station.

<u>Bulky items</u> will be charged \$7.50 an item (i.e.: couch, chair, area rug etc.).

Mattresses & Box Springs \$10.00 each.

TRUCKS

TRAILERS and MISCELLANEOUS DEBRIS

Length x width x height = number of cubic feet. Trailers will be charged \$.55 cents a cubic foot. 12'' = 1', over 12'-24'' = 2' etc.

BRUSH, LEAVES, TREES, AND STUMPS

Brush, leaves, trees, and stumps are not accepted at the Sidney Transfer Station. Use for composting or obtain burning permit online at www.wardensreport.com

PARTIAL LISTING OF UNIVERSAL WASTE FEES:

<u>COMPUTERS/ELECTRONICS</u> Monitors (17" or less), televisions, desk top copiers /printers, scanners, fax machines, CPU, laptops & UPS (Battery Back-up Systems) are all \$<u>7.50 each.</u> Other computer Peripherals (keyboards, mouse, speakers etc.) are <u>\$1.25 each</u>.

LAMPS All fluorescent lights (straight, circles, compact, u-lamps, HID lamps, coated or un-coated) are FREE.

ITEMS CONTAINING FREON

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or anything containing Freon is **\$10.00 an item**. Items cannot be combined with demolition debris.
