Recycling Fees:

Miscellaneous 'Consumer Electronics' such as Cameras, Typewriters, VCRs, Radios, Keyboards, Phones, Copiers: \$.25/pound. Wood console stereos and TVs, Projection TVs \$10/ea

Devices containing refrigerants, leaking batteries, exposed or broken CRT tubes, light bulbs, fire & CO detectors, mercury switches
